- A. **Military:** Will not be imported or re-exported for use by or for a military end-user or military end-use or satellite end-user or satellite end-use.
- B. **Chemical/Biological:** Will not be imported or exported to be used in the design, development, production, stockpiling, or use of chemical or biological weapons and their precursors.
- C. **Missiles:** Will not be imported or exported to be used in the design, development, production, stockpiling, or use of missiles. [The term “missiles” is defined as rocket systems (including ballistic missile systems, space launch vehicles, and sounding rockets) and unmanned air vehicles systems (including cruise missile systems, target drones, and reconnaissance drones) capable of delivering at least 500 kilograms (kg) payload to a range of at least 300 kilometers (km). Reference Export Administration Regulations (EAR) part 742.5].
- D. **Nuclear:** Product and/or replicas\* thereof will not be used (either directly or indirectly) in sensitive nuclear end-uses, as follows:

1. **Nuclear explosive activities:** Nuclear explosive activities, including research on or development design, manufacture, construction, testing or maintenance of any nuclear explosive device, or components or subsystems of such a device.
  2. **Unsafeguarded nuclear activities:** Activities including research on or development, design, manufacture, construction, operation or maintenance of any nuclear reactor, critical facility, facility for the fabrication of nuclear fuel, facility for the conversion of nuclear material from one chemical form to another or separate storage installation, where there is no obligation to accept International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) safeguards at the relevant facility or installation when it contains any source of special fissionable material (regardless of whether or not it contains such material at the time of export), or where any such obligation is not met.
  3. **Safeguarded and unsafeguarded nuclear activities:** Safeguarded and unsafeguarded nuclear fuel cycle activities, including research on or development, design, manufacture, construction, operation or maintenance of any of the following facilities, or components for such facilities for the:
    - a. Facilities for the chemical processing of irradiated special nuclear or source material
    - b. Facilities for the production of heavy water;
    - c. Facilities for the separation of isotopes or source and special nuclear material; or
    - d. Facilities for the fabrication of nuclear reactor fuel containing plutonium.
- E. **Embargoes:** Will not be imported or exported to destinations embargoed by the U.S. government (unless parts and components exemptions apply). This list is available from the II-VI Export Control Unit in Saxonburg, PA, U.S.A.
- F. **Denial list:** Product will not be re-exported to entities listed on U.S. government denial lists: U.S. Dept. of Commerce Denied Persons List, General Order #3 to EAR Part 736, State Dept. Debarred List, State Dept. Non-Proliferation Sanctions List, and Treasury Dept. Specially Designated Nationals List. These lists are available from the II-VI Export Control Unit in Saxonburg, PA, U.S.A.
- G. **Entity List / Unverified List:** Product will not be imported or exported for use by the end-users listed on the Entity List, Supplement No. 4, Part 744 of the EAR or the Unverified List ([www.bis.doc.gov](http://www.bis.doc.gov)) without approval from the U.S. Dept. of Commerce or the II-VI Inc. - H. **Re-exports:** Written authority will be obtained from the Bureau of Export Administration prior to re-exporting the items or technology, unless they would be eligible for re-export from the United States to the new country of destination under U.S. export law.
